**Missed or Cancelled Lessons**

- a) A **teacher-cancelled lesson** may, at the discretion of the teacher, be made up at a time and place agreeable to the parent and the teacher. Otherwise, the teacher's fee for such a teacher-cancelled lesson will be refunded in full to the parent by the School.
- b) **Parent or student-cancelled lessons** or missed lessons will not be refunded. If they are unable to attend their regular lesson time, students are encouraged to trade lessons with another student.
- c) Exceptions to and exemption from the above policy will only be considered by the Finance Committee and/or the Personnel Committee for consideration received in writing.
- d) **Weather-related school cancellations** shall be tied directly to the Upper Grand District School Board's cancellation decision. Lessons are only cancelled if the Schools are cancelled, not if only the busses are cancelled. Faculty will be paid for such cancelled lessons. Parents should check AM1460 CJOY radio station for cancellation information.
